Other resource persons include Ms. Libby Dometita, Project Manager of the Participatory Governance Project, Mr. Rico Gaurino, officer in charge of DILG-Sorsogon, and Mr. alex Jasareno, training officer of IRDF.

Ms. Dometita explained the different tools of analysis such as problem tree analysis, institution's analysis, and

stakeholder analysis whereas Mr. Gaurino tackled the provisions of the Republic Act 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 with emphasis on the powers of the barangay being the basic political unit of the government. On the other hand, Mr. Jasareno gave a brief background of the Republic Act 8550 or commonly known as the Fisheries Code of 1998.

The participants exhibited interest in the topics that have been discussed and were very active during open forum at the end of every discussion made by the resource persons.

Towards the end of the training, IRDF staff distributed certificates of participation to all members of the three aforementioned organizations who joined in this two-day training.
